*The pool is reserved for adults (16 and older) from 10am to 11am each Saturday, with the exception of Saturdays on which there is a swim meet, and 10am to noon each Sunday. A dedicated lap lane is available for dedicated lap swimmers.

- **Independence Day** 11:00 AM to 6:00 PM
- **Labor Day** 11:00 AM to 5:00 PM

Please note, pool hours may be impacted by swim team activities, including but not limited to:

Afternoon swim practices, which begins on Tuesday, May 26th and goes through Friday, June 19th. During this time period, swim practice will be held Monday to Friday from 4:30 PM to 6:30 PM. Starting on Monday, June 22nd, swim practice will move to the morning before the pool opens.

Pavilion Use

Planning a summer birthday or event? Pool members can rent half the pavilion for up to 2 hours for just \$50. Please note: there will be no party attendant provided.

Reservations and Questions: Email membership@rfpool.com to request a reservation or ask questions.

Important Details: Outside food is allowed; Guest passes are required for all non-member guests: \$3 on weekdays and \$5 on weekends; and Pavilion reservations are confirmed only after the rental payment is received.

Payment Instructions: Payments must be submitted within one week of booking; Make checks payable to Rolling Forest Recreation Association, Inc.; Include your customer number and "pavilion" on the memo line; Deliver payments to our secure mailbox at the pool entrance or mail them to: 7011 Flax St, Springfield, VA 22152

Unavailable Dates: The pavilion cannot be reserved on the following dates due to special pool events: Opening Weekend, Fourth of July Weekend and Closing Weekend. Reserve early to secure your spot!

Sugar Shack

Our goal is to have the Sugar Shack open as often as possible. Opening of the Sugar Shack is based on volunteer availability. To do this we need your help to staff the Sugar Shack! You don't need to be a swim team parent to volunteer. Swim team parents, please note, Sugar Shack volunteer hours outside of swim team events, will not count toward your volunteer hours for the swim team. When the Sugar Shack is not open, ice cream and drinks are available for purchase from the lifeguard shack.

You can pay at the Sugar Shack with cash or Venmo. To use Venmo, you must spend \$5.00 or more. We do not accept credit cards. Sugar Shack cards will be available for purchase from the Sugar Shack and lifeguard shack for \$20. Sugar Shack cards have a \$20 value and can be used to purchase items from either the Sugar Shack or lifeguard shack.

2026 Membership Categories & Dues Structure

Our pool dues continue to remain one of the lowest in the area! The RFPA will not be increasing dues this year. Membership rates remain the same from the 2025 season.

Charter Membership – \$540

Charter Members in good standing are guaranteed access to the pool, have voting rights that other members do not have, and are eligible to serve on the pool board. Charter Members who choose not to join the pool/continue their membership, will lose their rights as a Charter Member and may rejoin the pool in future years as an Associate Member.

Associate Membership - \$620

The Rolling Forest Pool welcomes members from outside of Charter Membership to join the pool. Associate Members are free to join the pool each year. Associate Members do not have voting rights and are not eligible to serve on the pool board. However, they are permitted to participate on committees and planning groups.

Charter Membership Rent-Out

Charter Members in good standing who do not wish to swim have the option to “rent out” their membership. The rent-out fee for 2026 remains \$100. To rent out your pool membership for the 2026 season: Submit payment of the \$100 rent-out fee to Rolling Forest Recreation Association, Inc. To initiate the process please email treasurer@rfpool.com and membership@rfpool.com to request the rent-out. You will receive a confirmation email once your request and payment are received. If the pool cannot rent out your membership to an Associate Member, you will be responsible for the remaining \$440 of the full \$540 membership dues. Requests are processed on a first-come, first-served basis. Submit your payment and request early to secure your spot.

Charter Member Landlord/Tenant Procedures

This must be done annually. If you are a landlord and would like to convey your membership to your tenants this season, please email treasurer@rfpool.com with the names and contact information of your tenants. Payment options:

1. You may pay the membership on behalf of your tenants. To do so, please see *Paying Your Dues* below.
2. Your tenants can pay the dues directly. They can either pay by check, see *Paying Your Dues* below or by credit card once their Member Splash account has been activated.

If you are a landlord and plan to personally use your membership tied to your property this year, your tenants will be afforded the opportunity to join the pool as an Associate Membership. Memberships only cover one household.

Guest Passes

Guest Passes must be purchased for all non-member guests. The guest fee is \$5 or 5 credits per guest.

Guest Passes can be purchased online through MemberSplash:

- **Login to MemberSplash** (<https://rollingforest.membersplash.com>)
- **Go to Payments > Make a Payment**
- **Select the number of Guest Credits you would like to purchase.**
You can either purchase 20 Credits for \$20 or 60 Credits for \$50. \$1 = 1 Guest Credit
- **Pick a payment Method – Credit/Debit or Check**
- **If paying by check, send in your check.**
You can mail in your check, drop it in the mailbox at the entrance to the pool, or leave it with a lifeguard at the front desk. Note, if paying by credit card, you will be charged a credit card processing fee.
- **When checking in with guests, the appropriate number of credits will be deducted from your account.**

You can also pay by cash or check for guest(s) at the front desk.

Member Splash

Member Splash is our front desk check-in system and primary method for communicating with members throughout the pool season. To ensure that we have an accurate listing of your household members and up to date contact information, please log into and ensure your information is accurate and complete.

To log into your account please complete the following steps:

1. Go to <https://rollingforest.membersplash.com> and click on the Log In link at the top of the page.
2. If you ever lose your username & password, you can use the retrieve username & password link, but this requires a valid email address on file. You can store one email address per adult member by clicking the edit icon next to their name on the account management screen. If you have any trouble accessing your account, please contact membership@rfpool.com.
3. Please make sure that all household member information is up to date. Please remember, all members must have the same permanent address.
4. Edit all info for each member. To do so, click on the edit link next to each member's name and edit phone, email, gender, member type and/or date of birth. Upload a face shot of each individual in your family membership under their name.
5. Add emergency contact info. To do so, click on the edit button next to emergency contact info and add the correct info.

Paying Your Dues

As always, you have the option to pay your membership by check or credit card. Please note, that if paying by credit card you will be charged a fee of 3.05%.

If paying by check, please make checks payable to Rolling Forest Recreation Association. Please include your customer number on the for memo line. You can drop your check off directly in our secure mailbox located at the entrance to the pool or mail your check to:

To pay by credit card, log into MemberSplash at <https://rollingforest.membersplash.com>. For additional details for logging in reference the Membership Registration section above.

1. Once logged in, click on the big red banner at the top of the page.
2. Select "Credit" or "Debit" as your payment method
3. Enter your billing information. Make sure you are using the address which is associated with your credit card.
4. Enter your credit card number, expiration date and CVV.
5. Click Submit Order
